COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Over the course of the last two years, the courts have rendered several decisions regarding search and seizure that have had a major impact in this area. This course will explain the importance of writing search warrants and the surrounding issues, such as, when it is appropriate to seal a warrant or parts thereof, rules for sealing a warrant, use of telephonic warrants, and essential basics of what is needed for a solid warrant that will withstand judicial review. Additionally, as each portion of the warrant writing process is discussed, new rules from the courts will also be discussed along with new cases in the areas of inventory searches, Qualified Immunity for law enforcement on warrants, searching cell phones, and a review of search and seizure since the decision rendered in Arizona v. Gant.
